Agency Updates:

Head Start: The program is in the midst of getting Early Head Start under way. They have hired a consultant from the University of Kentucky and a Sept date is the when the first services will start. The expansion groups have started as of Jan 20, 2010. Transition meetings are going well. Self assessment organizational meeting is Thursday Feb 18 at 12:30. If you can't make the meeting your participation is still welcome.

IDP: The agency is selling candy to benefit the stretch and grow program.

Visual Services: Lindsay had brochures which she distributed. She would be happy to answer any questions.

Department of Health: Flu shots are still being given. The immunization clinics are operating and have been busy.

Health Fairs: There are two health fairs at the University in April. The first is April 17 and it is being presented by the PA department of the University. The second is the annual Children's Festival which is April 24th.

Safe Kids: There will be an article on the dangers of a child death from an adult rolling over on them accidentally when they are sleeping on a mat or a sofa. This is the result of a child death review team meeting.

CCIS: Tobi Diggs has taken a new position and is temporarily doing three jobs. Her new job is contract specialist. There is a waiting list in Clinton County for child care subsidy but not in Lycoming County.

CEG: The CEG grant regulations are out and Laurie needs letters of intent from everyone by March 1st. If we are not eligible for match through the hours we provide we could count in kind services.

Ongoing Business:

Child Find Screening: Our next screening is March 15th. Wendy sent around a sign up list please help if you can.

School Transition: The next workshop is scheduled for March 19 at Ross Library. Leadership Breakfast: Invitations have gone out and there is some interest in Clinton County. This is the first joint venture with Lycoming County so it is just the start. Kindergarten Registration update: Registrations started Tues 2/16/2010. Laurie has provided material on school readiness and it is part of the packet that is being given to each parent.

School Readiness Workshop; The Dickey kindergarten teachers have agreed to do a workshop on what parents can do to help their children get ready for Kindergarten. It will be sometime in May and invitations will be sent out to the families of children who have registered for Kindergarten.

PA One Book Event: In April Laurie will be scheduling readers for child care settings and will be distributing copies of the book to children. Volunteers to be readers are welcome.
