II. Minutes from the last meeting were reviewed. Wendy Lupold moved and Sue Chapin seconded that the minutes be accepted as presented. Motion carried.

III. Agency Updates:

CIU#10: They are working on two grants. The first is Positive Behavior. They have four community partners but none in Clinton County. There will be a two day training of the core leadership team on Dec 9th and 10th. The Assistive Technology grant is also involved in team training. The team attended the AT Expo and there is training at Pattan on Dec 3rd. CIU#10 is also a pilot county for PELICAN implementation which means they will GO LIVE in February. There has been a change in kindergarten transition requirements which make it easier for districts to meet the timeframes required for evaluation and be ready for services when the child starts kindergarten.

Infant Development Program: There is an inspection November 23. They are having an in-service December 11 and a Family Holiday Party on December 18. That will be the last program day until Jan 4, 2010. Dawn Jeffries of Stepping Stone will be having parent appreciation day on December 16 and 17.

Lycoming-Clinton Head Start: Federal expansion classrooms will be opening in January. The state funded classes are just getting started. The mental health advisory committee will be meeting on December 2 at 1 at the Head Start Office on Boyd Street Williamsport. There is also a program for Dads Males with Nails that has been very successful in involving fathers.

Infant/Toddler Program: The new revised Learning Standards are now available from Pattan. There will be a State ICC meeting December 3. IU17 is a video link site so that interested persons could attend the meeting by going to the BLaST office on Reach Road Williamsport.

Community Engagement Group: The transition grant has been submitted. The transition day received excellent feedback. The leadership breakfast in February is a joint project of the Lycoming and Clinton CEG. Collaborative Board will meet on November 20. The State meeting for CEG coordinators will be December 2 and 3 at the Penn Stater.

IV. Sub committees

The training subcommittee members are: Barb Wilson, Wendy Lupold, Lisa Bangson, Laurie Welch and Sue Chapin. It was suggested that they explore the idea of training on Bridges out of Poverty. Two local university professors presented at the transition day and it was very well received. They are Denise Tyson and Christine Remmling. Child Find Screening Committee:

There were 9 preschoolers scheduled and 8 were screened. This resulted in five referrals to IU 10 and 1 to IU 17. There were 3 infant/toddlers screened which resulted in 1 referral for further evaluation.

There is a need for more supplies for the screenings. Vickie Dodds moved and Marilyn Ely seconded that we use LICC funds to purchase file folders, postage and any other needed supplies. Motion carried.
